



LA COURT 84 FORMS COMMITTEE TO EXPLORE DUES ADJUSTMENT OPTIONS

(Member Survey to Follow Before Final Proposal and By-Law Change)

n an effort to ensure the continued financial health and sustainability of LA Court 84, a special committee has been established to explore options for adjusting annual dues.

Under the direction of Court leadership, the committee has been tasked with developing several potential dues structures or plans that will meet the Court's operational needs while taking into consideration the diverse perspectives of its membership.

Once the committee finalizes its proposed options, members of LA Court 84 will be invited to participate in a survey. This survey will serve as a key step in gauging the general consensus of the Court and gathering valuable feedback from the Nobility.

The information collected from the survey will inform the committee's final recommendation. Following this consultative process, a formal proposal will be submitted for approval and will proceed through the appropriate channels for a by-law change.

"This is a collaborative effort," said Rick Norris. "We want to ensure that any changes to our dues structure reflect the collective voice of our members and support the long-term vitality of LA Court 84."

Members are encouraged to stay engaged and participate in the upcoming survey once released.
